In our tumbling classes we will maintain a consistent level of proper progression and continually work on the fundamentals at all levels. Fundamental training is vital to the safe and successful completion of any athletic program.

We strive to maintain a 1:8 instructor:athlete ratio in all classes. Tumbling classes are one hour long. We reserve the right to cancel or combine classes at any level based on the number of athletes in a class.

ANNIVERSARY FEE

All athletes will be charged an anniversary fee of \$65.00 per family. This fee is good for one year or until you leave the program.

MAKE-UP POLICY

Because of our strict instructor:athlete ratio, we do not offer make-up classes. Missed classes will not result in make-up classes, prorated tuition or refunds. No refunds for classes missed, including scheduled holidays.

DROP PROCEDURE

PARENTS MUST NOTIFY THE GYM TO DROP A STUDENT FROM CLASS. YOU WILL NEED TO LOG INTO THE PARENT PORTAL AND REQUEST TO HAVE YOUR ATHLETE DROPPED FROM THE CLASS IN ORDER FOR THE SYSTEM TO STOP MONTHLY BILLING.

Please note: You are responsible for payment for your athlete's classes WHETHER OR NOT YOUR ATHLETE ATTENDS CLASS until the time you notify the staff by dropping the class on the Parent Portal or in writing. Do not rely on your athlete to verbally tell us that he/she will no longer be attending class. If an athlete stops attending class without notification then the account will still be charged for the additional 30 days. This charge will be for holding the place in the class instead of allowing someone else from a waitlist to join.
